Head of the Center for Legal Support to Economic and Social Reforms of the Institute of Legislation and Comparative Law under the Government of the Russian Federation, Chief of the Scientific and Educational Center on International Cooperation in the Field of Labor and Social Security (ProMOT) of the Kutafin Moscow State Law University (MSAL).



MIKHAIL A. KOVALEVSKY, Professor of the Department of public health and health care of the State Budgetary Educational Institution of Higher Professional Education "Evdokimov Moscow State Medical and Dental University". Specialist in the field of medical law, constitutional law, insurance law, commercial law, social security and pension law. Author of over 170 research works, including 20 monographs and 4 textbooks. He was director of the department of legal and international activities of the RF Ministry of Public Health and Social Development, Advisor to the RF Constitutional Court Chairman. He taught at the Department of Commercial Law of St. Petersburg State University, at the HSE Department of Economy and Health Care Organization and other universities. He was and currently is member of various expert and advisory councils at the federal government, expert of Russian and international organizations. He participated in the drafting of a significant number of federal laws and other normative legal acts.



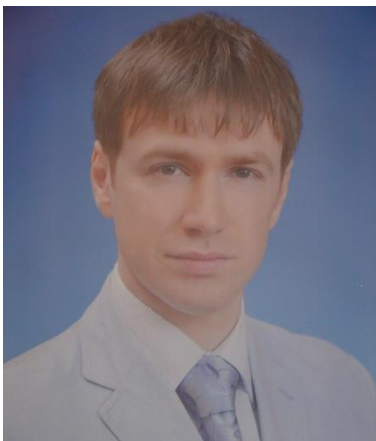

Member of the St. Petersburg Association of Medical Law (part of the World Association of Medical Law).



NATALIA S. Specialist in the field of insurance law, commercial law, health law and social law. Author of more than 70 research works, including 11 monographs and three textbooks. Was an official expert of the RF Presidential Administration, the RF Government, the RF Supreme Council, the RF State Duma, the RF Constitutional Court, the RF Ministry of Public Health and Social Development and the Federal Foundation of Compulsory Medical Insurance, a number of Russian and international organizations. Participated in the drafting of a significant number of federal laws and other normative legal acts.
